NEW IN 2011

CMMF had a busy and landmark year! Partnering with different organizations across Canada, the Foundation launched its mineral card series. The first set of cards was developed in conjunction with Dynamic Earth in Sudbury. A beautiful series of cards highlighting international minerals were created and distributed to students at the M4S mining education show, held during the annual CIM Convention in Edmonton in May 2012. This project became the point of reference for CMMF's mandate "to promote the industry and support education" across Canada. From this initial partnership, many other partnerships and collaborations were organized to promote prominent Canadian collections and showcase some of the country's finest minerals. Each card is accompanied, on the CMMF website, by an information page about the mining company, museum or university program that has sponsored the card. Thanks to the support of generous sponsors and donors, the mineral cards are available free of charge to educators, students and the general public at www.cmmf72.org (mineral cards).

In 2012, CMMF began touring with M4S showcasing the mineral card project at the M4S educational shows and providing students with the opportunity to see how minerals are important in their daily lives.

In addition to the M4S educational show, CMMF has continued to participate in the CIM trade shows, offering information about the Foundation, its mandate, programs and activities, including the mineral card project. In 2012, CMMF was invited to participate at the following CIM-related events:

The Foundation continued to award scholarships to deserving mining students and helped establish two new scholarships, one in Engineering and the other in Exploration Geology, offered by the CIM Montreal Branch. These two new scholarships will be awarded to students studying mining in the province of Quebec. The Canadian Mineral Processors Society of CIM has also created a new scholarship for students studying mineral processing.

In 2012, the Hydrometallurgy Society, Canadian Mineral Processors Society and the CIM Montreal Branch have all decided to use the CIM Foundation to administer the funds for their scholarships. CMMF is currently in discussions with other CIM constituents regarding the management of their funds.
